Parenting Through Proverbs

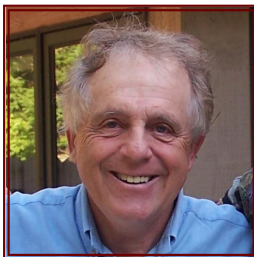

Normal Christian Life

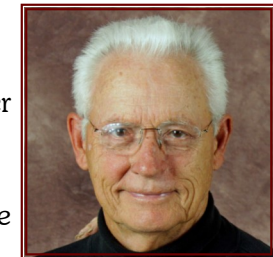
